Subject: Authorization for release of 1st installment of Grant-in-Aid to the Government of Manipur for establishment of Fifty Two (52) Anganwadi-cum-Creches (AWCCs) during the financial year 2023-24.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the Competent Authority to the payment of **Rs. 54,10,620/- (Rs. Fifty Four Lakh Ten Thousand Six Hundred Twenty only)** of Grant-in-Aid to the Government of Manipur being 1st installment for establishment of **Fifty Two (52) Anganwadi-cum-Creches (AWCCs)** during the financial year 2023-24. The amount being Govt. of India Share towards **non-recurring grant and one quarters of recurring grant** for the financial year 2023-24 as per details given below:



2. As per the instruction of the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Funds released to the States/UTs from the major head 3601/3602 shall be necessarily with cost sharing from the States as 60:40, except in respect of North Eastern and Special Category States where the cost sharing ratio shall be 90:10. For UTs without legislature, 100% funding will be provided by the Central Government.

3. The Grant-in-Aids is subject to the following conditions:

- (i) That the funds sanctioned shall be utilized for the purpose for which it is sanctioned. A separate account in respect of the sanctioned amount is to be maintained.
- (ii) States/UTs will submit, every quarter, progress of Project & expenditure of the grants released to them along with the Progress Report on the running up of AWCCs.



- (iii) States/UTs will submit the item-wise Statement of Expenditure (SoE) duly signed by the authorized officer before claiming next installment of GIA.
- (iv) States/UTs will the Utilization Certificate (UC) in Gorm-19A of GFR, duly signed by the authorized officer along with SoE.
- (v) States/UTs will also submit Progress Report on the Project as well as requirement of Funds for demanding the next installment of GIA.
- (vi) All the interest and other earnings against Grant-in-Aid will be remitted to Consolidated Fund of India (CFI) immediately after finalization of the accounts or as per the instructions of Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure.
- (vii) Utilization Certificate in format GFR-12 C will be submitted by the State Government in respect of the Scheme. The UC should be countersigned by the Administrative Secretary of the Division regulating the Scheme/Finance Secretary.
- (viii) The revised budgetary provisions/norms for AWCCs are enclosed at **Annexure**.

4. The expenditure involved is debitable to Budget Head **3601.06.101.82.09.31**, Ministry of Women & Child Development, for the financial year 2023-24.

5. The amount of grant-in-aid is finally adjustable in the books of the Principal Pay and Account Office, Ministry of Women and Child Development, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi- 110001. The payment of State Government would be arranged through Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur. The State/UT Accountant General will send intimation regarding receipt of Grant-in-aid to the Principal Pay & Accounts Office, Ministry of Women and Child Development, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi.

6. The accounts of the Grantee Institutions or organization shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organization is called upon to do so.

7. This sanction issues with the concurrence of the Integrated Finance Division (IFD) of Ministry of Women & Child Development vide **Computer No. 113437 dated 26th March, 2024**.
