Subject: Release of Grants-in-aid to the State Government of Uttar Pradesh for implementation of Ujjawala Scheme under the Revised Guidelines of the scheme – reg.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of President to the payment of **Rs.83,01,000/- (Rupees Eighty Three Lakh One Thousand only)** to State Government of Uttar Pradesh as first installment of grants-in-aid (50% of GOI's share) for the year 2016-17 for implementation of the Ujjawala Scheme under the Revised Guideline.


2. The Ujjawala Scheme is a sub-scheme of the Centrally Sponsored Umbrella Scheme "Prevention, Rescue, Rehabilitation & Re-integration for Women" with prescribed cost sharing between Centre and States/UTs. In the above release, the Central Government contribution has been calculated on 60:30:10 ratio and sanction of funds is subject to the following conditions;

- i. The amount of the grant will have to be utilized for all components under the scheme as per the schematic norms.
- ii. The States/UTs shall also be required to contribute their share for implementation of the Ujjawala scheme.
- iii. States/UTs may, in particular, ensure that the rent is paid in accordance with the existing Rent Agreement till its validity or Rent Assessment certificate, where applicable as per scheme.
- iv. The State Govt. may ensure that before release of fund to the NGO that utilization certificate has been received of previous fund released.

3. The grant is further subject to condition that the State Government will maintain separate records of expenditure incurred for implementation of Ujjawala scheme and furnish separate Statement of Expenditure and Utilization Certificate along with Physical Progress Report every half year.

4. The information on expenditure on Ujjawala from 1st April, 2016 to 31st March, 2017 must be furnished by 15th April, every year to enable the Ministry to work out the entitlement of Central assistance of each State Government/UT Administration.

5. The payment is provisional and is subject to final adjustment in the light of the audited figures of actual expenditure for the year as a whole. The grant-in-aid is subject to the condition that when the Scheme is closed or abandoned, the proceeds from the disposal of assets built out of the whole or a portion of the grant sanctioned will revert to the Central Government.

The expenditure is debitable to Demand No.97, Major Head 3601 – Grants-in-aid to the State Governments – 02 – Grants for State Plan Schemes, 356 – Social Welfare – Women Welfare, 02 – Scheme for Protection and Empowerment of Women, 04 – Comprehensive Scheme for Combating Trafficking of Women and Children (Ujjawala), 02.04.31 – Grants-in-Aid General for the year 2016-17 for the Ministry of Women & Child Development.
7. The amount of grant-in-aid is finally adjustable in the books of the Principal Pay and Accounts Office, Ministry of Women & Child Development, 'D' Wing, Ground Floor, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi. The payment of the State would be arranged through the Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur. The State Accountant Generals will send intimation regarding receipt of grant-in-aid to the Principal Pay & Accounts Office, Ministry of Women & Child Development, Shastri Bhawan, 'D' Wing, Ground Floor, New Delhi.
8. The pattern of grants has been approved by the Ministry of Finance. This sanction is being issued in conformity with the rules and principles of the scheme approved by the Competent Authority.
9. This sanction issues with the concurrence of IFD vide their **Dy.No.24845/JS&FA** dated **20.11.2016**.
10. Entries have been made in the Grant-in-aid Register at **Sl.No.34**.
