Subject:- Minutes of the 7<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Project Sanctioning Committee on UJJAWALA-A Comprehensive Scheme for Prevention of Trafficking and Rescue, Rehabilitation, Re-Integration and Repatriation of Victims of Trafficking for commercial sexual exploitation.

A meeting of the Project Sanctioning Committee (PSC) for 'UJJAWALA'- a comprehensive scheme to combat trafficking, was held on 02.06.2010 at 11.00 A.M., under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Ministry of Women & Child Development), in Room No. 601, 'A' Wing, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi. The PSC considered proposals received from the Non-Governmental Organizations, duly recommended by the State Governments. A list of participants is enclosed at Annex-I.

2. In all, 35 proposals from 8 States of Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Nagaland, Tamil Nadu, Tripura and West Bengal were considered by the Project Sanctioning Committee. Of these the Committee approved 9 proposals, deferred 9 and rejected 17 proposals as per details given below:

The list of proposals approved/ deferred/ rejected by the PSC is given at Anne- II, III and IV respectively. In respect of cases approved, the amount sanctioned will be as per the schematic norms.

- 3. It was also decided that the State Government should:-
  - (i) Periodically review the functioning and performance of all Ujjawala projects being implemented in the State and inform MWCD of the outcome of such review.
  - (ii) Ensure that all organizations which are sanctioned Rehabilitation and Reintegration Homes, send photo identities of all the beneficiaries in such Homes. These photo identities should be continually updated.
  - (iii) Ensure that the NGOs furnish a quarterly progress report to MWCD.

4. Since none of the NGOs who applied for assistance had the requisite experience and capacity, the PSC recommended that the State Governments of Arunachal Pradesh and Nagaland may themselves send a proposal for setting up a rehabilitation home in their respective States.
