Subject: Implementation Guidelines for Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana regarding.

Madam/Sir

I am directed to refer this Ministry's letter No. 11-9/2017-MBP dated 19.05.2017 conveying approval for Pan-India implementation of Maternity Benefit Programme and to inform that the Scheme has since been named as "Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (प्रधानमंत्री मातृ वंदना योजना)".

- 2. The Ministry has now formulated the implementation Guidelines for the Scheme. These have been finalised after extensive discussions with States/UTs and other line Ministries/ Departments of the Government of India. The implementation guidelines are available at Ministry's website i.e. <a href="www.wcd.nic.in">www.wcd.nic.in</a> which may be downloaded and translated in local language for circulation among stake holders. The physical copies of the guidelines are being send separately.
- 3. The guidelines can also be used by partner agencies and training institutions. It is expected that these guidelines will be used by the target audience as a reference manual for effective implementation of the Scheme at the grass root level. The Hindi version of these guidelines will be uploaded on the Ministry's website shortly.
- 4. The immediate next steps required to be taken by States/UTs are:
  - i. Implementation Guidelines may be translated and widely circulated in local language(s), as required.
  - ii. Guidelines contain forms for registration and claiming benefits under Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY). These may be translated, printed and circulated among all concerned. It may be ensured that forms in sufficient number are made available at the Anganwadi Center or approved Health facility of the State/UT.
  - iii. These guidelines also contain formats for furnishing Annual and Quarterly Utilisation Certificates and Progress Reports which needs to be submitted to the Ministry in due time.
  - iv. Training of concerned ICDS and Health functionaries at all levels may be organised and completed by 30.09.2017.

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- v. The Guidelines includes budgetary norms for setting up of PMMVY Cells at various levels. A proposal for setting up of State and District PMMVY Cells may be submitted by 31.08.2017.
- 5. I am directed to request you to take actions suggested in para 4 above immediately so that PMMVY could be rolled out smoothly across your State/UT.
